

# Workshop C - BSMS Developments

## **VANESA**

- Data extraction should be more accessible, user-friendly, and include data summaries
- Have a monthly report facility - emailed out rather than accessed via website
- User configurable so will remember local or previous settings
- Easily available report for hospital, regional, and national

## **Guidance from BSMS**

- Act as an intermediary for best practice
- Be more active in offering guidance to participants; don't act as monitor
- Feedback to participants on how to improve performance
- Offer support to trusts in attempts to improve stock management.

## **Data Collection**

- Extend range to include FFP, cryo, paediatric packs
- Breakdown of wastage by hospital directorate
- Include clinical reason for transfusion

## **Participation**

- Should be mandatory - involve MHRA
- Hospitals should be able to select if they would like their data to be de-anonymised.
- Avoid 'Name & Shame'
- Facilitate information sharing between participants

## **Fate of Donation (EDI)**

- Hurry up!
- Include clinical data using ICD or anaemia codes

## **Reporting**

- Cumulative data to see trends
- Year-on-year comparisons
- Link usage level to activities/specialities within the hospital
- Report on data related to distances and deliveries
- Regional comparisons

## **Training**

- Hold more regional training courses / user groups

## **BiteSize Projects**

- Conduct more BiteSize Projects
- Conduct one on bank holiday planning
